Nomination Form

As a part of our celebrations during Brain Injury Awareness Week, we will be recognising an outstanding individual who has made an extraordinary contribution to people living with ABI.

Our selection committee will determine who has made the most significant contribution during the past 12 months.

This award provides the opportunity for people living with brain injury, and their relatives and carers, to acknowledge someone who has provided extraordinary service and assistance.

Who can be nominated?

Simply anyone. It might be a therapist, doctor or specialist, community service worker, personal care attendant, service coordinator, legal practitioner, employment support worker who has provided service excellence during the past 12 months.

How many people can I nominate?

You may nominate one person who has demonstrated service excellence through their work. Service excellence includes treating people with respect and dignity, providing clear information, and generally going 'above and beyond' in providing assistance.

Who can nominate someone for the Service Excellence Award?

Only people who have experienced brain injury, their relatives or carers can nominate.

Presentation of Awards will be held on **Monday 19 August 2019, during the Brain Injury Awareness Week (BIAW) Launch.**
