## The express Reconnect Transition Program (eRTP)

### As part of its visit to Port Lincoln, Brain Injury SA is running the eRTP.

**A free group program for people with acquired brain injury (ABI). Sponsored by the Motor Accident Commission, the eRTP is open to those whose ABI resulted from a motor vehicle accident or other road trauma.**

Facilitated by registered psychologist Ed Weaver, the eRTP provides people with the opportunity to learn more about ABI, discuss their experiences and challenges, connect with others in the community, and put in place strategies for the future.

#### The eRTP includes such topics as:

- Understanding the brain
- Exploring the challenges of ABI
- Emotional wellbeing & building resilience
- Interpersonal relationships
- Planning for the future & goal setting
