Brain Injury SA provides Community Access Support to participants of the Lifetime Support Scheme, a service that brings professional support staff together with individuals, their families and service providers to ensure continuity of care.

We use a creative and flexible approach to support participants through a wide-range of day-to-day activities, ensuring they have access to quality services.



Services are entirely tailored to each participant's needs and can include:

- Facilitating referrals to services, therapies and activities
- Working with service providers to understand the goals of the participant
- Working closely with support agencies to deliver services which meet the clients' and informal carers' needs
- Assisting individuals to manage their finances including ensuring they are receiving appropriate income support, eligibility for concessions and referrals to financial counsellors if required
- Assistance to maintain tenancies including housing applications and referrals to support services if required
- Assistance to enrol in educational programs and link people to student support services
- Support attendance to medical and specialist appointments
- Facilitating community integration and helping people connect with social and support groups
- Enhancing self-advocacy for the client.
